

RECITAL INFORMATION - IMPORTANT!!!

Below you will find all the information you need for recital week at The Vilar. All dress rehearsals and performances are held at The Vilar. Please make sure to read all information carefully. There are a lot of dancers participating in these performances and keeping everything organized is our goal! We will be handing out recital costumes after Spring Break. Your account needs to have a zero balance for your dancer to receive their costume(s).

Drop-Off and Pick-Up -

All dancers need to be dropped off and picked up at The Artist Entrance at The Vilar. This entrance is to the right of the loading dock door. There is a table in the loading dock that will be used to check the dancers in and out. Dancers who are under 12 years old, need an adult to sign them in and out. If the dancers are over 12 years old, they can sign themselves in and out. This is a requirement of The Vilar. Dancers **MUST** be picked up at the Artists Entrance, they **CAN NOT** go up through the lobby to exit. Only dancers in the May Gallery dressing room may check out from there and leave through the front.

Costumes, tights, leotards, shoes, hair, and makeup -

There is a spreadsheet attached to this email with all the classes listed and what they need for each class. Please check this list as you pack your dance bag. If the dancers have more than one costume, they need to have a nude leotard to wear underneath. Use the link below to find the nude leotards. Scroll to the bottom of the list. You will find adult and children's sizes. Please read the spreadsheet carefully!

Packing List -

Wearing to the Vilar - First costume, tights, hair done, and make up on! (Dancers with bangs are allowed to wear the bangs down, they do not need to slick them back).

- All shoes needed for each dance. (Please label your dancers shoes with their name)
- All costumes needed for each dance. Please steam any costume that needs it before coming to The Vilar.
- Nude leotard for any dancer who is changing costumes.
- Hairbrush or comb – this is to help with any hair issues that may arise.
- Bobby pins – all dancers must have at least 15 bobby pins each.
- Hairspray/gel – this is to make sure the dancers do not have any flyways.
- Water bottle – please label the bottle with your dancer's name. NO sugary or colored drinks are allowed.
- Snack - please send your dancer with an easy to eat and clean up snack. Fruit snacks, apple slices and grapes are good examples.
- Coloring Book/iPad - please send your dancer with something that they enjoy working on during the breaks between their dances. (VVAD and The Vilar are not responsible for lost items).

These are our youngest dancers. Their parents will be allowed to sit in the audience and wait for them to finish their dress rehearsal. This is the only time parents will be allowed downstairs.

This will be 3 total dances. Tippy Toes has one dance and Beginning Dance 1 has a ballet and a tap dance.

5:15pm – Release time for Tippy Toes and Beginning Dance 1

5:00pm – Arrival Time for Beginning Dance 2 and Beginning Dance 3

We will follow same routine for this group as the younger group.

5:30pm-7:00pm – Dress Rehearsal for Beginning Dance 2 and Beginning Dance 3

This will be 6 total dances. Beginning Dance 3 has two separate days and each day has a tap and a ballet dance. Beginning Dance 2 has a tap and a ballet dance.
